December has been a bit more relaxing as my visits have included club Christmas parties, a party for special needs students hosted by the Youngstown Lions, Zone Meetings, the 50th. Charter Celebration of the Suffield Lions, the induction of 7 new Lions to the Boardman Club and 4 new Lions to the Poland Club. It has been a great December!

As our second half of the year begins, I want to encourage each club to actively build their membership. It is critical that we welcome new members with new ideas! If we can't grow and attract younger members, Lions like some other service organizations will disappear from our communities. That is something we all do not want to see happen.

As your representative to the State Finance & Planning Committee, I can share with you that discussions have been held talking about dues increases and REDISTRICTING. We just finished that process and I sure do not want to see us go through that process again. When we increase our membership numbers the discussions can stop! As of our November report, District 13 OH 4 has 1517 members. At the beginning of the Lions year we had 1,553 members. We lost 52,7 to death and the other 45 for other reasons. My challenge to each Lion is if we all would recruit ONE member by June, our membership could double to 3,034 serving Lions. The result would be MORE Service to our communities and the end to the discussions of redistricting and dues increases. Let's take this on in roaring Lion fashion!

In total, 200 were in attendance, including 103 students, teachers and student aids, bus drivers, visually impaired guests from Goodwill, Lion dignitaries and club members.


It was a very special day and great way to kickoff the holiday season.
